The Clinical Ethics Consultation Benchmarking Collaborative (CECBC) is a group of collaborators who want to learn more about clinical ethics practices in the United States, with the aim of improving the benchmarks by which we understand and assess our work. The project began as the result of a peer-to-peer problem-solving session during the 2022 UnConference sponsored by WellStar Health. At the ASBH 2023 meeting in Baltimore, the first CECBC data were presented, covering 316 hospitals who provided data during our first year of data collection.
